

Is GCS < 15?

Heart Rate < 60 or >120  
SBP <90 or > 180  
RR <8 or >24

Blood Glucose < 60 or > 300

Has the patient vomited 4 times or more?  
Vomiting bright red blood or coffee grounds?

Any Known seizure activity in the last 24 hours?

Report or Evidence of Head Trauma in the last 24 hours?

Any tremors or hallucinations?

Unable to walk without assistance?

Unsafe Environment? (3)

If the answer to any of these questions is yes, transport or process as High-Risk Refusal.

If answer to all questions is NO, proceed with processing patient as a Low-Risk Refusal

1. Patients must be at least 18 years of age to implement this evaluation tool
2. Serious medical conditions can present as inebriation. It is the pre-hospital provider's responsibility to rule out other causes.
3. Unsafe environment means a place where physical injury (trauma or hypo/hyperthermia) is probable
