PARAMEDIC JOB DESCRIPTION

The paramedic administers advanced life support to sick and injured persons in pre-hospital settings as authorized and directed by a physician, including protocols, as well as assesses the nature and extent of injury or illness to establish and prioritize medical procedures to be followed. Paramedics will be assigned to work 48 hours a week that is broken into 2 scheduled 24 hour shifts per week.

PARAMEDIC QUALIFICATIONS

- High School graduate or equivalent.
- Citizen of the United States.
- Good physical condition.
- Valid driver's license with good record.
- Valid Illinois Paramedic license, as well as, ACLS, PALS, and AHA CPR certifications.

POST EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS

- Successfully test into the OSF Saint James - John W. Albrecht Medical Center's EMS System.
- Complete a 12-month probationary period in good standing.
